RESOLUTION TO RESTORE LIFE MEMBER (INITIATION) FEE TO \$300.00

(A Resolution Submitted by **Narendra Pattani** and **Dr. Vipin Mithia**)

Whereas:

- The 2002 AGM resolved to have the Annual Membership Fees as follows: \$25/- for Life Members, \$50/- for GTA Members that are not Life Members and \$30/- for Non Life Members outside of GTA.
- This resolution, for the AGM in early 2006, does NOT deal with these Annual Membership Fees, and these annual fees shall remain unchanged whether or not this resolution is accepted by the AGM.
- The Annual Membership Fees have been more than sufficient, over the past three years, to meet the normal funding requirements for the Community and to allow for a reasonable reserve to continue building up.
- The 2002 AGM also resolved to increase the fee for (initiating) Life Membership from \$300/- in 2002 to \$501/- effective 2003, \$750/- effective 2005, and \$1,001/- effective 2007.
- Most of the current Life Members became so after paying \$300/- and there have been almost no new Life Members since the increase in 2002 (or perhaps there were no more than two such members since the fees were increased).
- The higher level of charge for Life Membership causes undue hardship on Lohanas such as the new adults, including newly married individuals who grew up amongst us, and the new immigrants who are trying to establish in this country under much hardship. It is inappropriate to use the disposable incomes of the established families and professionals (many of who became Life Members earlier) as a barometer to determine the appropriate level of the Life Membership fee.
- The inequitable treatment for such new adults and new immigrants is not consistent with our aim to extend a helping hand to all Raghuvanshis and to encourage an inclusive atmosphere within the community. Further, such an inequitable treatment can be, and is, a cause of alienation among many new adults and new immigrants. It should be noted that some of the new adults and new immigrants are very active individuals serving our Community with utmost diligence.
- At this critical stage of our Community in Canada – when there are many other organizations, events, and commitments competing for attention and when individuals have limited time – we need to embrace and welcome our new adults and new immigrants rather than treat them as a source of additional funding. Let us therefore resolve to unite the Lohana family and to give equitable and fair treatment to all Lohanas so that they feel that they are wanted.

Therefore,

- 1) It is resolved that, with immediate effect after this AGM, the initiating fee for becoming a Life Member shall be restored to \$300/-.**
- 2) All other resolutions passed at the 2002 AGM shall continue to be effective.**

Dear Lohana Community Member,
